I, the undersigned incorporator, hereby agree to form and establish a corporation NOT for profit under the laws of the State of Kansas

The name of the corporation is Baldwin City Chamber of Commerce Incorporated.

II

The location of the registered office in the State of Kansas is 721 8th Street, Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas 66006, and the registered agent in charge thereof at such address is Robert Woodhead.

III

The corporation is organized NOT for profit and the nature of its business or purposes to be conducted or promoted is to advance the general welfare and prosperity of the City of Baldwin City so that its citizens and all areas of its business community shall prosper. All necessary means of promotion shall be provided and particular attention and emphasis shall be given to the economic, civic, commercial, cultural, industrial, and educational interests of the area.

IV

The corporation shall not issue stock.

V

The conditions of membership shall be established by the by-laws of the corporation.

VIII

This corporation shall not engage in any business of any kind ordinarily carried on for profit, and nothing in the Articles of Incorporation or in the constitution or by-laws shall authorize the corporation to, and the corporation shall not enter into any transaction, carry on any activity, or engage in any business for pecuniary profit, and any income received by the corporation shall be applied only to the non-profit purposes and objectives of the corporation set forth herein, and no part thereof during membership or upon termination of members shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, Board of Directors, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of

the corporation shall be the carrying on of propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles not permitted toe carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of the assets of the corporation by delivering the same to the City of Eudora, a municipal corporation, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

IX

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.


